Greek Educational System

The education in Greece is obligatory for all children between 6 and 15 years old. However, the school life of the students can start from the age of 2.5 years (pre-school education) in institutions (private and public) called Kindergartens. The duration of study in Primary Education is six years, with an entry age of 6 years. Along with the common Kindergartens and Primary Schools, there are also All-Day schools, which have extended opening hours and an enriched Curriculum. Post- compulsory Secondary Education includes two types of schools: the Unified Lyceums and the Technical Vocational Schools (TTE).



The duration of study is three years in the Unified Lyceums and two or three years in the Technical

Vocational Schools. Along with the common schools of Primary and Secondary Education, there are also Special Kindergartens, Elementary, Gymnasiums, Lyceums and lyceum classes, which are addressed to students with special educational needs. There are also Music, Ecclesiastical and Athletic Gymnasiums and Lyceums. The post-compulsory Secondary Education also includes the Vocational Training Institutes (IEK), which offer non-formal education.



They accept both High School graduates and Lyceum graduates, depending on the individual specialties they offer. Public university education is divided into universities and technical institutes. The admission of students to these institutions depends on their performance in national level exams that take place in the last class of the Lyceum. Formal education is characterized by a fixed duration of studies, repeatability, and the award of an official degree at the end of them, which is also its state legitimacy. The

graduation of educational institutions implies the obligation to hold the certificate (diploma, degree, etc.) of the previous level of studies to continue to the next.

Our school

Our school is one of the biggest schools in my town. It has been built on a hill and is located in one of the most ancient and important areas of my city.

First of all, it's got a lot of facilities. Specifically, it has nine classrooms, three for each grade, while classrooms in which third-grade students take classes have interactive tables. In addition, there is a gym where there is fitness equipment. We even have an IT lab and a library. The courtyard at my school is huge and includes a basketball court, a football field and two volleyball courts. Finally, our teachers have their office located on the second floor along with the event hall which has a huge capacity.
